### Supporting Moms | Maryland Retreat



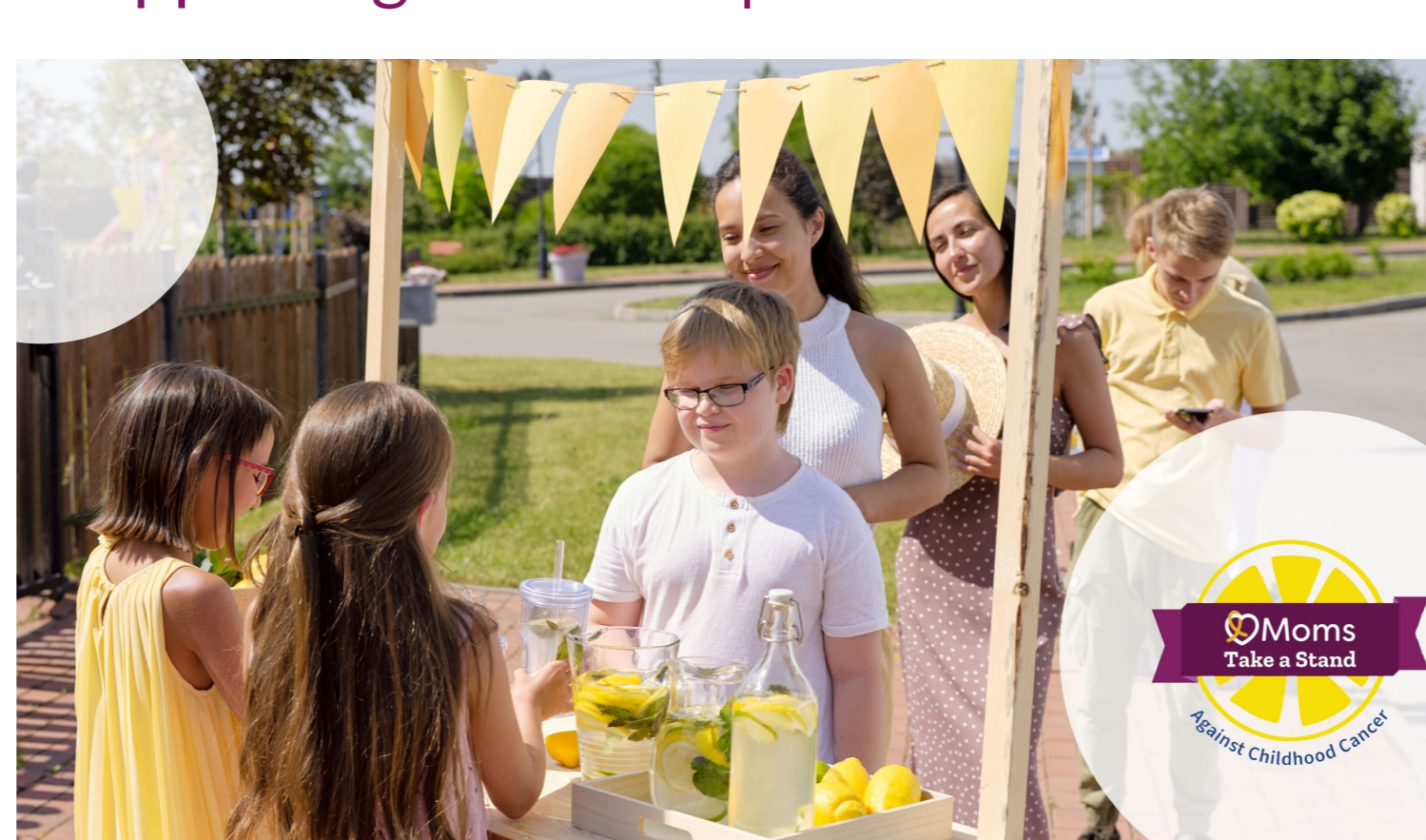
#### Applications are now open for our next Momcology Retreat.
